EXHIBITION DATES: The show will be viewable on our chapter website <https://cpsa207.org/> from November 1, 2021 until January 2, 2022.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

Artists may enter up to THREE pieces completed within the last five years.

There will be two categories: members with signature status (CPSA, CPX) and those without.

(CPSA and/or CPX Signature status is attained by being accepted three times in a ten-year period into the CPSA International Exhibition and/or Explore This!)

The artwork can be for sale or NFS. Buyers will be directed to Karen Smith, vicepresident@cpsa207.org, who will put them in touch with the artist to make final arrangements. There is no commission. (When discussing a purchase with an interested buyer remember to state if the artwork is framed, just matted or neither. Also calculate packing and shipping costs if those are necessary.)

Artwork must be solely the original concept, design, and execution of the submitting artist. Reference photos used in creating the artwork must be taken personally by the submitting artist; however, reference photos taken by anyone other than the submitting artist may be used as reference for incidental areas only, NOT for the main focus of the artwork. Artwork derived from an instructor's design or class-room project and completed by the artist is not allowed. You may, however, submit artwork of your own original design which was worked on in a class or critiqued by others, as long as you are the primary creative force.

MEDIA: The media used can be 100% colored pencil or predominantly colored pencil pigment along with any other medium (watercolor, acrylic, oil, pastel, ink, etc.).

PUBLICITY: A digital postcard will be produced and distributed for you to send to all your family and fans.

AWARDS JUDGE: Denise Howard, CPSA, UKCPS, MPAS, PAS, will judge the show for awards which will be in the form of ribbons. She is the national Marketing Director of the CPSA. See her work at <https://www.denisejhowardart.com/>

PREPARE YOUR IMAGES FOR SUBMISSION:

Images must be no smaller than 1280 pixels wide or 800 pixels high, saved as a jpg and less than 3 MB in size. Images must be cropped to exclude matting, frame or any other extraneous visual information.

Label the jpeg thus: Lastname-Firstname-Title.jpg.
